ADMISSION

Admission process for Playgroup starts in the month of **December.** The prospectus and Application Forms are generally issued by the first week of January from the office. Admission to all other classes are subject to vacancies. Those desirous of seeking admission (**to classes LKG to IX**) should submit the request for admission by the **first week of January**. In case of any vacancy, the parents may collect the Prospectus and Application forms from the school. Further process and observation will be conducted in the month of January. Admission to Class XI will be held immediately after the declaration of Class X CBSE result for internal as well as external students on the basis of merit and vacancy. The details regarding dates and other information about the admission procedure will be available on the school notice board and website

SCHOOL UNIFORM

It is compulsory for all the students to attend the school in the prescribed uniform. It's not just education but school gives the platform to nurture faith, emotions at early stage of life. The importance of making friends and working as a team is learnt at school. And wearing the same dress definitely brings a sense of unity among students who come from different backgrounds. With the school uniform they become one. The only identity dominates at that moment is all of them are the 'representatives' of the same school. This is a great feeling of togetherness. It also helps kids to overcome inferiority or superiority complex. It flashes out most of the drops of social conflicts. We make sure that it keeps students from bickering and fighting over individual fashion and also eliminates social stereotyping based on fashion.

WITHDRAWAL

"A written notice must be given in advance for withdrawal of any student." All applications for the **School Leaving Certificate** should be submitted in the prescribed format available at the school office and it should be duly signed by the parent. The application for the **School Leaving Certificate** is to be submitted before 31st March. If the application comes after that, the parent has to pay fees for one quarter. The School Leaving Certificate will be issued only after all the dues have been cleared. Duplicate copy of the School Leaving Certificate is generally not issued. Such certificate will be issued in special cases only after the parent furnishes an affidavit stating that the School Leaving Certificate has been irrecoverably lost and that they will be solely responsible for any possible misuse later. If any parent applies for withdrawal in first term before June month quarterly fee will be refunded.

HOUSE SYSTEM

There are Four Houses in the School

- ★ Each student is allotted a house, which is headed by a House Captain, a House Vice Captain and number of House prefects.
- Each house has various committees for supervision, discipline, cleanliness and maintenance of bulletin board.
- The House Leader is a member of staff, who is In-charge of each house. Several other teachers are an integral part of the respective House as House Tutors and one as Deputy House Leader. All of them serve as mentors to the children in their respective Tutorial Groups. They look after their general well-being, as well as their academics, sports and co-curricular performance.

Points are awarded to the students of each house throughout the year for their individual and collective performance in academics, co-curricular activities, games and sports.

SCHOOL FEES

- School fees, caution money & transportation fees have to be paid in advance in online mode.
- Once the admission is confirmed, the parent will receive a WhatsApp Message on the registered mobile number from the School which contains USER ID & PASSWORD. Parent should login to the student portal to pay the fees and for other information.
- The School has set-up online payment system for the convenience of the parent. Hence, there is no need for the parent to visit the school office to deposit the school fees. School fees will be accepted only through **ONLINE** mode. **NO OFFLINE MODE.**
- Term-I payment is to be made between 1st April to 15th April.
- Term II payment is to be made between 1st October to 15th October.

- Kindly note school fees paid after the scheduled date Late fees charges will be automatically added on daily basis and the same will reflect at the time of payment. Hence, please pay the school fees in time to avoid any embarrassing / unpleasant situation.
- No School business will be transacted on a Holiday.
- The parent will receive an intimation regarding the receipt of school fees on your registered WhatsApp Number and a digital receipt at the same time.

GAMES, SPORTS AND CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The holistic and all round development of the students is the prime objective of the institution. With the academics the children are groomed into skillful individuals through wide ranging co-curricular activities and sports & games.

They are exposed to elocution, poem - composition and recitation, story telling, action songs, handwriting, science / maths quiz, drawing & painting, dramatics etc.

The glimpses of such talents can be witnessed on the occasion of special celebrations and Annual Day.

Children performing extraordinary in these contests are awarded merit certificates and if required, qualify for more grace marks in **one** subject from the principal's discretionary quota, for consideration of their annual promotion at the end of the year.

CIRCULARS / NOTICES from the school

- Whenever a circular is sent along with the acknowledgement from the school, parents/guardians must acknowledge the receipt of the same by signing it. They are earnestly requested to read it carefully and follow the matter given in the circular.
- A Parents/guardians are expected to go through the contents of the almanac carefully. Any parent/guardian who has doubt about any point or points is most welcome to contact the school and seek necessary clarification within 7 Days of the receipt of the almanac.
- Since digital messages are sent to parents to disseminate the important information and details, it is the sole responsibility of parents to **provide correct Whats App Number to school.** Parents/guardians are expected to read all the Whats App messages sent on regular basis on the class group and consider it as official circular. You are requested not to write a reply or send any message on the group as it is one way communication channel.
- The school authorities will presume that the Parents/Guardians will do so and that they will agree to respect, co-operate and abide by the rules and regulations mentioned in the almanac.

GENERAL RULES

This almanac must be brought to the school everyday and the instructions to be followed in letter and spirit. Daily lessons, reports and homework should be taken down by the students.

- 1. Student should come to school on time. Repeated unpunctuality will be punished. Students who reach late shall not be permitted to attend the classes and will be sent back home.
- 2. Students must come neat and tidily dressed to school.
- 3. Irregular attendance at school, habitual laziness, disobedience, dishonesty or undesirable conduct are sufficient reason for dismissal of a student.
- 4. Any student, who is found to have done damage of any kind in class or school premises has to compensate the damage done by paying three times the purchase price. Students must take care of their belongings; the school authorities will not be responsible for loss or damage.
- 5. No book / periodicals / other articles unapproved by the Principal should be brought to the school premises.
- 6. The students are responsible to the school authorities for their conduct both in the school and outside.
- 7. No visitors (parents or others) are allowed to see the pupils or interview the teachers during class hours without the permission of the Principal.
- 8. Parents are requested to avoid making any social engagement or medical appointments during school working hours. If the child is found genuinely ill, the parents will be called to take the student back from school. No child will be allowed to leave the school premises during the working hours except in **cases of exigencies**. Parents are requested to sign the register available at the school reception before picking up their wards. They can approach the class teachers who will assist them in contacting the child.
- 9. Promotion from one standard to the higher one will be strictly in accordance with the rules framed by the school from time to time and the conduct of the student in the school during the year. The decisions of the school authorities in matters of promotion will be final and no representations from parents/guardians either for promotion or for detention will be entertained. Student who fail in Annual Examinations for two consecutive years will not be allowed to continue in the school.
- 10. Student suffering from any contagious disease will not be permitted to attend the classes and the management will be entitled to remove the names of such students from the rolls.

- 11. Students shall wear the respective uniform assigned for the day even during the examination. Hair to be properly cut, oiled and combed.
- 12. If a student need to visit the school for any reason he / she must come in school uniform.
- 13. No student is allowed to wear low waist pants / skirts. Parents / Guardians are requested to take special care in sending their wards to school in neat & proper uniform.
- 14. Bringing cameras, cell phones, electronic items, I pods, fireworks, exploding crackers, splashing water or colour in the school premises is strictly forbidden even during festival times. Non-compliance of these instructions can result in expulsion from the school.
- 15. Sports equipments such as cricket bat & ball, football, volley ball, tennis ball etc are available with the sports department and made available to the students during their games/PE classes. Hence parents may keep a check that their wards don't carry these sports equipments to school.
- 16. Students must not carry sharp objects like knife, pokers, scissors, blade, cutters etc. They must not carry deodorant, cosmetics to the school. If found it will be confiscated by the school authorities.
- 17. Any forbidden items (costly ornaments) found with the student will be confiscated and kept in the custody of the school.
- 18. Student must remain present on special working days such as on **last** working days prior to examination, vacation, Independence day, Republic Day and on Re-opening Day.
- 19. In case a student misses any periodic test without a proper reason or permission he/she will not be given a second chance for the same.
- 20. A light breakfast every morning would keep the child energetic & healthy. A child who comes to school with only a glass of milk, remains hungry for almost 15 16 hours (the time between the night meal and lunch time at school which is at 11:30 a.m.). It is difficult for a hungry child to concentrate and participate in any school activities. You are requested to send some light home made nutritious snack for the short recess and proper meal (Chapati + Vegetables / Pulaoo / Veg. Biryani etc. for Lunch) this is to ensure that they have their proper fill. Growing children need enough stamina to face the challenges of the day.
- 21. Students are not permitted to bring chocolates / chewing gum / cakes / pastries /gifts on their birthdays or their teacher's birthdays. Students of Classes Jr. K. G. to V are permitted to wear dignified coloured outfit appropriate for the school on their birthdays. Girls of VI to XII are permitted to wear long kurtis- pants / salwar kameez, Boys of VI to XII may come in formals. No tight jeans will be allowed.

- 22. Please note that the attestation of photographs of students studying in the school would be done only on the photographs taken in the school uniform.
- **23.** If any student requires percentage certificate from the school then he / she should apply before 30th April of the new academic year.
- 24. If a child has to stay back in school then parents will be informed by the Teacher in-charge. The parents have to fill up the stay back form prior with signature and the students need to inform the Class Teacher regarding the same. The filled up stay back form will be collected by the teacher concerned. (The format is given on the pg no. (138) for the reference)

Parents are requested to co-operate with the school & ensure inculcation of values in children. Let's join hands and work towards the betterment of our future generation.

- 1. Regularity and implicit obedience are expected in the school.
- 2. Speaking in English is must for students in the school premises.
- 3. Students are made to realise that they are responsible to the school authorities not only for their conduct in the school, but also for the general behaviour outside. Any reported or observed objectionable conduct out of the school on part of the students should make them liable to disciplinary action.
- 5. Parents should be aware of the facts that the management has a right to say on what conditions they will admit or retain pupils in their school.
- 6. Strict action will be taken if any student is found damaging the school property.
- 7. Students shall not take part in any political activities or unethical online / cyber activities.
- 8. Any student who is persistently insubordinate or is repeatedly or wilfully mischievous or is guilty of unauthorised practice in connection with examinations or of unauthorised alterations in leaving certificates or who in the opinion of the Principal has an unwholesome influence on his / her fellow students, may be removed from the roll. The removal may be temporary or permanent, according to the gravity of the offence.

Evaluation pattern Education in 21st century has taken a paradigm shift from the traditional learning to competency based education. It aims at holistic development of student in both the academic and non academic spheres. It focuses on developing different learning skills, literary skills & life skills. Education should make the students confident in dealing with real life situations & develop social capacities, good behaviour, courtesy, personal & public cleanliness and team work. In the view of above thought, the NEP 2020 is implemented which aims at promoting better overall learning and development.

Evaluation Pattern

Class I and II

There will be total four periodic test(written) each of 20 marks during the entire year. Oral, note book work and subject enrichment activities will be important part of evaluation

The assessment structure and examination for class I & II will comprise two terms i.e. Term I and Term - II. Under Scholastic area, each term will have two Periodic Tests of 30 marks and Internal assessment of 10 marks. The internal Assessment break up will be 5 marks weightage to Notebook assessment and 5 marks weightage to subject enrichment activity. Hence the assessment will be (60 + 10 i.e. 70) term wise. The students need to secure minimum 10 marks (33%) out of 30 to pass in each Periodic test whereas secure minimum 4 Marks out of 10 marks (33%) to pass in the Internal assessment (i.e. Notebook and Subject Enrichment).

The child should secure minimum 33% of marks overall in each subject in each term separately to qualify for the next higher class.

Class III to V

There will be two periodic test each of 30 marks and one half yearly of 50 marks and one annual exam of 50 marks. Oral test, note book and subject enrichment will be important part of evaluation .

The assessment structure and examination for class III to V will comprise two terms i.e. Term I and Term - II. Under Scholastic area, each term will have one Periodic Test of 30 marks and half-yearly exam/Yearly Exam of 50 marks and Internal assessment of 20 marks. The internal Assessment break up will be 10 marks weightage to Notebook assessment and 10 marks weightage to

subject enrichment activity. Hence the assessment will be (30+50+20) term wise. The students need to secure minimum 10 marks (33%) out of 30 and minimum 17 marks (33%) out of 50 to pass in the exam whereas secure minimum 7 marks (33%) out of 20 marks in the Internal Assessment (i.e. Notebook and Subject Enrichment).

The child should secure minimum 33% of marks overall in each subject in each term separately to qualify for the next higher class.

Class VI to VIII (As per CBSE guidelines)

The assessment structure and examination for classes VI to VIII will comprise two terms i.e. Term I and Term - II. Under Scholastic area, each term will have one Periodic Test of 40 marks and half-yearly exam/Yearly Exam of 80 marks and Internal assessment of 20 marks. The internal Assessment break up will be Periodic Test- 10% weightage whereas notebook assessment 5% and subject enrichment 5% weightage each. Hence the assessment will be (80 + 20) term wise. The students need to secure minimum 27 marks (33%) out of 80 to pass in the exam whereas secure minimum 7 marks out of 20 marks in the Internal Assessment.

The half-yearly exam of 80 marks will have the syllabus covered till half yearly exam dates whereas the Annul exam will have the following weightage:-

 $Class\,VI-10\%\,of\,I\,term\,covering\,significant\,\,topics+entire\,syllabus\,of\,II\,term.$

 $Class\,VII\,-\,20\%\,of\,I\,term\,covering\,significant\,topics\,+\,entire\,syllabus\,of\,II\,term.$

 $Class\ VIII-30\%\ of\ I\ term\ covering\ significant\ topics+entire\ syllabus\ of\ II\ term.$

If the child fails to score aggregate 33% marks in any subject then the child will have to write improvement exam in the particular subject.

For classes IX & X (As per CBSE guidelines)

There will be 3 Periodic Tests. The Annual examination of 80 marks will be conducted covering the entire syllabus and the students need to secure minimum 27 marks to pass. Class X will have 80 marks Annual Board examination. The best two scores of 3 Periodic Test will be considered for calculation and converted into 5%, whereas multiple assessments, notebook assessment and subject enrichment 5% weightage each will be assessed before every test and then will be averaged into (5+5+5) i.e. 15 marks. The students need to secure minimum 7 marks out of 20 marks.

PROMOTION CRITERIA FOR CLASS IX (As per CBSE guidelines)

- 1. A student has to secure a minimum of 33% marks in internal assessment to be eligible to appear in Annual Examination. In case a student does not secure 33% marks in Internal Assessment i.e. 07 marks he/she will not be eligible to appear in Annual Examination.
- 2. Promotion to the next higher class shall be decided on the basis of the cumulative result of Periodic Test, Subject Enrichment, Note Book and Annual Examination.
- 3. In order to be declared "Pass" at the end of the session, a student must secure at least 33% marks in main five subjects i.e. Two languages and three compulsory subject (Mathematics, Science and Social Science).

IMPROVEMENT / COMPARTMENT EXAMINATION FOR CLASS IX (As per CBSE guidelines)

- 1. A student who appears in Annual Examination can be declared eligible for appearing in the improvement/ compartment Examination in not more than <u>two</u> failing subjects.
- 2. For subjects involving Internal assessment, in case the candidate has passed in Internal Assessment, he/she shall appear only in theory part and previous Internal Assessment marks will be carried forward.
- 3. If the student fails to secure 33% marks in the improvement/compartment, he/she shall be declared unsuccessful in the improvement/compartment Examination.

Note: Class X theory Annual Board examination will be governed by CBSE.

PROMOTION RULES FOR CLASS XI (As per CBSE guidelines)

- 1. **Promotion to the higher class** shall be decided on the basis of the cumulative results of **Periodic Tests**, **Class Tests**, **Half Yearly and Annual examination**.
- 2. In order to be declared pass at the end of the session, a student must secure 33% marks in each of the subject studied by him/her during the session subject to the condition that he/she secures 33% marks separately in theory and practical. The child must secure 33% marks in compartment examination to be promoted to the next higher class.

COMPARTMENT EXAMINATION FOR CLASS XI: (As per CBSE

guidelines)

- 1. A student will be considered eligible to take the improvement / compartment examination in **one failing subject only, if he / she scores minimum 20% marks in that subject.**
- 2. Out of five main subjects, a student who fails in theory, he/she will be placed in compartment in Theory. If a student fails in Practical will be placed in compartment only in 'Practical'.
- 3. If the student secures at least 33% marks in the improvement / compartment examination, he/she shall be declared successful in the Compartment Examination and will be promoted to the next higher Class.

Fail: (As per CBSE guidelines)

A student who fails to secure 33% marks in **more than one** subject will be declared Fail / Detained in the same class.

RULES REGARDING ABSENCE DURING EXAMINATION: (As per CBSE guidelines)

1. For all Classes: In case a student remains absent then medical certificate to be submitted within **three** working days of the date of absence at the exam, or else it will be considered as willful absence and no marks will be given for the day of absence.

The child remains absent on medical ground by giving the Medical Certificate then the **average** will be counted.

- 2. In case the student of **class IX** and **X** is unable to appear in either of Periodic Test 1/ Periodic Test 2/ Periodic Test 3 in one or more subjects on medical ground, no **Re-exam** will be conducted at school level. However, marks of **best two** out of three periodic Test to be considered for promotion.
- 3. A student of class IX or XI on leave on medical ground supported by a medical certificate in the **Annual** Examination in one or more subjects shall be allowed to take the exam in subject(s) (in which he/she has been on leave on medical ground) along with the students taking the Compartment examination.

Rules for Examination

- 1. Attendance is compulsory for all tests and examinations held during the year, failing which the student will be awarded zero. No consideration will be given to absentees, except on medical grounds at the sole discretion of the Head of School. It is the responsibility of both, students and their parents to ensure that they do not miss any Written Tests or Examinations.
- 2. In case, if a child is sick during exam and he / she is in the condition to write exam may be accompanied by one of the parents to the school. The child will be allowed to go home after the exam.
- 3. If the child is seriously ill or there is an exigency in the family, he / she will be given due weightage (as per the CBSE rules) OR will have to appear in the exam as per rescheduled date.
- 4. There is no provision for <u>re-testing</u> students, who remain absent otherwise on the day of the examination or those who have failed in one or more subjects.
- 5. A minimum attendance record **of 90% of the total number** of working days in each term is compulsory. Even on medical grounds, a child remaining absent for more than 20% of the total number of working days in each term, may be detained in the same class.
- 6. Grades will be awarded to students as per the marks scored in individual subjects in accordance with the **CBSE** norms.
- 7. Minimum $\bf D$ **GRADE** (33 %) is required for a student to be promoted to the next higher class.

LEAVE RULES

- 1. All students are expected to be present in the school on the notified date at the beginning of the school term / vacation. Leave may be granted to a student only on the following grounds:
 - a. In case of serious illness
 - b. Death of a very near relative.
 - c. To attend the marriage of close relation (Brother / Sister) any other unavoidable social function.
- 2. Leave for half day should not be asked for any reasons unless it is an emergency. In case of emergency, written permission must be taken from the Class teacher concerned and it should be approved by the Principal.
- 3. Leave application **upto two days** should be addressed to the Class Teacher. In case of **more than two days** leave, the application should be addressed to the **Principal** through the Class Teacher. Use prescribed leave format given in the appendices, for leave more than two days.
- 4. If on any day the attendance of a particular class becomes less than **85%**, all students remaining absent on that day shall be charged a special fine as decided by the school. Those students who have taken prior permission in writing for grant of leave would be exempted from this fine. Those absent on medical ground should report the matter over phone or in person by the parent and submit the medical certificate along with the leave application on or before they rejoin the school. No leave of absence will be sanctioned except on written application from the parents / guardians showing the valid reason. Parents have to enter details of absence in the diary also.
- 5. Prior permission has to be taken for reasons like going out of station, to attend a function, etc. which are known to the parents beforehand.
- 6. If the child is found genuinely ill, the parents will be called to take the student back from the school. For any other reason on request of the parent, if the child leaves the school early, attendance will be marked as **'leave'** in the attendance register.
- 7. Absence because of illness has to be reported to the school within two days. A medical certificate along with the leave application should be submitted on or before the student rejoins the school.

School Library Rules

The school library is open to all bonafide students of the School. Students visiting the library have to observe the following rules:

- 1. Books will only be issued to students for taking home from class VI onwards.
- 2. New book will be issued only after the previously issued book is returned.
- 3. Complete silence must be maintained in the library.
- 4. The library has an open access system, and the students must help to maintain the order and organisation of the collection in different shelves. They must place the books in the shelves strictly according to the call numbers, after consultation with the Librarian.
- 5. Reference books to be read in the library only and not be issued.

(except for class X & XII)

- 6. If books are returned late without a valid reason, the borrowing facility will be withdrawn for a period of 4 weeks or more.
- 7. If a book is marked, disfigured or damaged will have to be replaced by the borrower, failing to which the full cost of the book will have to be paid by the student, in case the issued book is lost the defaulter will have to buy the same book for the library of pay THREE time more to the price of the book.
- 8. Any student found deliberately damaging or defacing a book may be debarred from the library for the entire term or academic year.
- 9. Students are not allowed to bring their belongings to the library except water bottle.
- 10. Students are required to be seated at the allotted places.
- $11.\,If \,the \,book \,is \,not \,submitted \,on \,time \,Rs.\,5 \,\textit{/-Per day will be fined}.$

PARENTAL SUPPORT

- Parents must impress upon their wards, the need to come to school in time, in proper uniform, hair neatly combed and nails clipped and cleaned. This would build up the child's self- esteem.
- 4. Parents are required to inform the school immediately if there is any change in their address or telephone numbers, Whats App number in a prescribed Proforma given in the appendices.
- 5. Parents are requested to co-operate with the school and ensure that their ward speak in English inside the School Campus.
- 6. Despite the efforts made by the teachers to complete all revision work in the school, it would be appreciated if the parents also could do a little follow up of their ward's study at home.
- 7. Parents must acknowledge the performance of their wards in the Test/Examination and put their signature on the report card.
- $8. \quad \text{Parents are expected to plan holiday as per the school holiday list.} \\$
- 9. It would be our effort to organize Parent—Teacher Meetings regularly where parents could meet the teachers and discuss the performance of their wards. However, parents desirous of meeting the Principal or Teachers on any other occasion may do so after fixing up a convenient date and time.
- 10. No parents should approach teachers at their homes or on their personal number regarding school matters.
- 11. All parents are requested to meet the teachers at the respective class rooms on the days of PTM. Other than PTM days, the parents can meet the teachers with prior appointment on the designated day.

(Monday & Wednesday, Time: 2:00 p.m. to 2:30 p.m.

12. A written information will be sent by the concerned teacher to the parent whenever their ward has to stay back after school hours for any practice/special class/or any other work.

- 13. Any communication made by parents / guardians should be addressed to the Class Teachers first, and only those matters which require the intervention of the Principal should be addressed to her.
- 14. Parents are requested not to give the children valuable articles like expensive watches, calculators, cameras, cell phones, CDs, jewellery and other forbidden items to school. In case of any loss of valuables or other articles, the school authorities will try their best to trace these but shall not undertake any responsibility for the loss.
- 15. Parents are requested to put some identification mark on all the belongings of their ward.
- 16. Other than text books or library books, no other books should be brought to school without Teacher's permission. Bringing objectionable literature to the school may lead to severe disciplinary action.
- 17. Parents are requested to drop their wards at the main gate / pathway / reception area to the school and not to accompany their ward to the classroom. This would encourage independence and responsibility amongst the children.
- 18. Students who come to school under the care of guardian/attendant should never leave before he/she arrives to take them back. In case of delay, they should report to the school office.
- 19. All parents are requested to ensure that their child is not commuting to the school in an overcrowded auto-rickshaw / vehicles like van etc. The safety of the child should be your prime concern.
- 20. In no case, the higher class students are allowed to come to school by two wheelers / four wheelers.
- 21. School cannot be held solely responsible for accidents minor or serious, on account of student's indiscipline or disobedience during school hours, excursion and while travelling.
- (21) Parents are requested to fill student's profile given in almanac and also fix a recent passport size photograph of their ward within two days after the almanac has been issued.
- We believe in grooming our children with right values and respect for their elders. In this regard attention of parents is drawn to the fact that criticism of any teacher or school in the presence of their children should be scrupulously avoided because it causes them to lose respect for their teachers with the consequent failure to learn from them. It further hampers his / her progress. Kindly avoid discussing school matters in informal gatherings.
